Baby Grands High Performance Air Filter Installation Instructions

- 1. Remove any old air filters from the carburetors.
- 2. Remove the two outer screws on the upper locator bar of the carburetors.
- 3. Separate the new filter element from the backing plate and set the filter element aside.
- 4. Install the backing plate <u>only</u> onto the carburetors. This will be a tight fit. To make it easier, use some lubricant on the rubber grommets. Also, a small screwdriver may help to get the grommets over the carburetor openings.
- 5. Using the nylon spacer provided, place it between the backing plate and the carburetors and install the hex head bolt to secure the backing plate to the carburetors. Repeat for the other corner of the backing plate. Place a dab of blue loc-tite on the threads of the bolt to ensure it does not loosen over time.
- 6. Slide the air filter element in horizontally from the front of the backing plate until the twist nuts line up with the holes in the backing plate. Squeeze the rubber flange together with the backing plate while turning the twist nuts to lock the filter element to the backing plate.

Notes:

- 1. The filter element is pre-oiled at the factory and is ready to run.
- 2. Be sure to keep the filter element cleaned for best performance. Simply release the twist nuts and slide the element forward to remove. The backing plate will always stay on the carburetors.
